### **NJM/CLI Introduces the New High-Speed Cremer CF-425 Tablet Counter**

October 23, 2008 – NJM/CLI introduces the new Cremer CF-425 Tablet Counter at Pack Expo 2008. Featuring a versatile modular design with up to 10 counting heads, this advanced linear tablet counter maximizes production speeds within a space-saving footprint while handling a wide range of tablets, caplets, hard caps and softgels, and a wide variety of bottle shapes and sizes with fast and easy changeovers.

The number of counting-head modules on the new Cremer CF-425 can vary from three to 10 to match each customer's required line output. Typical output ranges from 90 to 300 bottles per minute, based on 100-count bottles. Actual output depends on the combination of product shape, size and count.

Compared to existing Cremer linear tablet counters that feature four counting heads, the CF-425 achieves this high throughput in 40 percent less floorspace. The CF-425's advancements include full control on all motions, easier operation with fewer parameters, electrically controlled enclosure over the counting modules and improved system efficiency.

The CF-425 tablet counter handles tablets, caplets, hard caps and softgels ranging in size from 2 to 30mm in length and from 2 to 20mm in width. It accommodates a wide assortment of containers, including round, oval, square and rectangular bottles up to 200mm high and 110mm wide. While many product and bottle changeovers can be accomplished on the CF-425 with only a limited number of changeparts, even the most extreme changeover can be achieved by one operator in a very short time.

The Cremer CF-425 simplifies operation and maximizes production efficiency by reducing mechanical adjustments during product set-up, operation, changeover and sanitation. The entire system is controlled from the operator interface with a 15-inch color touch screen.

Exceeding cGMP specifications, the CF-425 is made of stainless steel, hard anodized aluminum and various synthetic materials. Designed and built for unparalleled reliability and ease of operation, Cremer guarantees the CF-425 to be 100 percent accurate. This new tablet counter uses CFR21 part 11-compliant software.

NJM/CLI offers a detailed validation package with the CF-425 as well as full line integration services and bulk hopper feeders.
